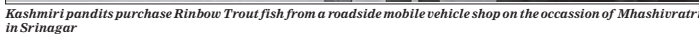

**NEW DELHI** 16 /— The Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) has withdrawn its directive against engaging retired employees in investigating corruption cases, citing "misapprehension in certain quarters". The probity watchdog had on January 13 asked public sector undertakings, companies and Central government departments not to engage retired employees in investigating corruption cases. The assertion had been made that it was not the intention of the Commission that some organisations were appointing retired employees as investigating officers, contrary to its existing, nearly two-decade-old, directive in this regard. The CVC has now issued a fresh circular regarding the withdrawal of the one-month's directive. "It has been brought to the Commission's notice that this circular has raised a misapprehension in certain quarters regarding the Commission's intention to instruct officials to conduct departmental inquiries. The matter has been examined and the above circular is withdrawn," it said in its latest order dated February 14.

In last month's order, the CVC had said that it was

have compromised confidentiality, objectivity or integrity, in the discharge of duties assigned to them. This is not possible in the case of retired officials as conduct and disciplinary rules do not apply to them for any post-retirement misconduct, it had said.

The Commission had in August 2000 directed that vigilance functionaries in any organisation shall be full-time employees and that a retired staffer should not be appointed as a consultant to perform vigilance functions.

"However, it has been observed that some of the organisations are still appointing retired employees as investigating officers, to conduct an investigation, which is an important vigilance function," the anti-corruption watchdog had said in the order dated January 13. The order was issued to secretaries of all central government

ministries/departments, chief executives of central public sector undertakings, banks and insurance companies among others. The CVC had said that investigating officers and other vigilance functionaries play a crucial role as they are responsible for recording statements, examining various aspects of a case, preparation of investigation reports and safe custody of documents, including classified ones.

Keeping in view the vital role of investigating officers and other vigilance functionaries in the detection, probe and processing of vigilance-related matter, it is very important that vigilance functionaries, including the investigation officers, are not susceptible to any kind of undue influence, it had said. In the letter, Rahul also requested the chief minister to grant the man's family ex-gratia compensation and a job for one of its members on humanitarian grounds. The man was found hanging near the medical college hospital at Kozhikode on February 11, where his wife was admitted for delivery.

"I request you to kindly initiate a probe into the circumstances surrounding the death of Vishwanathan and order an impartial enquiry regarding the lapses in investigation, if any," he said. (PTI)
